

Insurance

Lakeshore/Cardinal Coach tours strongly recommends the purchase of Trip Cancellation and Interruption Insurance, and comprehensive out of province Medical Insurance. As of July 4th, 2022, we will no longer be offering an in-house cancellation waiver, however we are authorized sellers of Manulife Travel Insurance. Please contact the office for a quote.

Publication Errors

We do our utmost to ensure the accuracy of our brochures, however typographical and pricing errors can occur, and we reserve the right to correct any errors without notice.

Rates

Our tour rates are calculated according to transportation fares, accommodation rates, and attraction costs at the time of printing. All Lakeshore/Cardinal Coach Tours include taxes and fees. Every effort will be made to maintain the tour rates; however, we reserve the right to adjust prices at any time if this becomes necessary for a tour to run. To join our multi-day tours, participants must be capable of walking extended distances at a reasonable pace and comfortably navigate multiple staircases. We strongly recommend that you carefully choose a tour that does not exceed your physical capabilities. This choice should align with or exceed the designated "activity level" outlined on the Lakeshore/Cardinal website and brochure for the specific tour itinerary you intend to join. Some of our tours are not suitable for individual's requiring wheelchairs or walkers. If you have concerns about your physical capabilities in relation to our tours, we encourage you to engage in a conversation with one of our reservation agents. They can assist you in selecting the tour best suited to your activity level.

Right to Refuse Service/Removal From Tour:

In the event that you choose a tour that exceeds your physical or cognitive capabilities, and you are unable to keep up or are consistently holding up the group, Lakeshore/Cardinal reserves the right to remove you from the tour, and any associated costs will be your responsibility. No refund for unused services will be provided. Additionally, we hold the authority to decline any individual as a tour member at our sole discretion, at any time and for any reason if, in our judgment or in the judgment of a third-party service provider on the tour, a guest's condition may impact the health, safety, or overall experience of other travelers. Challenges and Limitations:

Please be aware that certain tours may involve considerable walking and could pose challenges to travellers with disabilities or mobility constraints. Many historic sites are accessible solely on foot and may feature stairs or hilly terrain.

Activity Levels

Level One – Light I enjoy exploring with plenty of options to sit and enjoy the surroundings.

- I have no problem walking unassisted or with a mobility device, at a relaxed pace for up to 400 meters with short breaks to catch my breath.
- I can climb at least one flight of stairs, board a motor coach without assistance, stand for minimum 10 minutes, and get on/off an escalator without assistance.
- Travel companions are suggested for those passengers with mobility constraints and are required if you cannot manage any of the above on your own.
- Please note that foldable wheelchairs or walkers cannot exceed 50 lbs.

Level Two – Moderate Travel for me is a balance between actively exploring new things and relaxing.

- I have no problem walking unassisted at a moderate pace for 1-2km with some short breaks.
- I can climb at least one flight of stairs, board a motor coach without assistance, manage a variety of terrain and moderate hills with rest stops. I can stand for minimum 15 minutes.
- Navigating large venues, malls, airports, and hotels is doable with a little guidance.
- This level is not suitable for travellers who require mobility assistance devices (i.e.) walkers, wheelchairs.

Level Three – Active I am an active traveller. I love exploring, walking, and standing for longer periods of time.

- I have no problem walking unassisted at an active pace for up to 3-5 km with rest stops scattered throughout.
- I can climb at least 3-4 flights of stairs and manage navigating uneven terrain, cobblestone, and hills at a medium pace with rests.
- Navigating large venues, airports, and hotels is not a problem.
- This level is not a suitable for travellers who require mobility assistance devices of any type.

Level Four – Very Active I live a very active life. My FitBit may often measure upwards of 10,000 steps in a day!

- I have no problem walking unassisted at an active pace for 5+ km a day with short breaks.
- I can climb multiple flights of stairs throughout the day, navigate uneven terrain, and steeper hills with no issue.
- I can stand for longer periods and manage a variety of altitudes and temperatures.
- Navigating large venues, airports, and hotels is not a problem.
- This level is not suitable for travellers who require mobility assistance devices of any type.

Full Disclosure of Disabilities:

To ensure your safety and a fulfilling tour experience, it is mandatory to disclose any physical limitations or cognitive disabilities to your booking agents before confirming your tour reservation.
